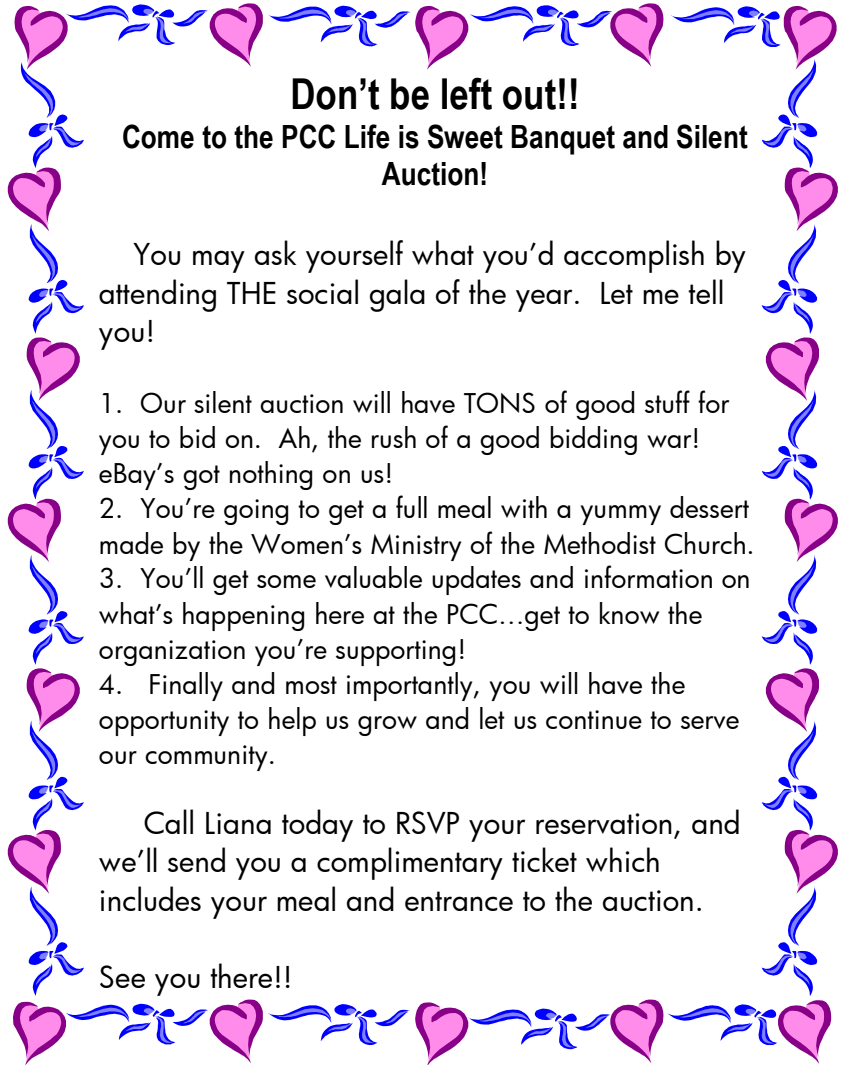
What does the PCC office have in common with a psychedelic hippie pad of the 1970's?
